Degree Overview – All Degrees

- All Hosts Keep Ceremonials Chairman informed of degrees
 - Primary Point of Contact for degree Grand Knight, DD, or team captain
 - Contact information phone number and email
 - Location of Degree especially if council serves several parishes
 - Time for candidates to report and time for "gavel drop"
- All Councils Accompany Candidates
 - "Never let a candidate go to a degree alone"
 - Sideliners are welcome and can be asked to participate
 - Degree Schedule posted periodically at OCKC.net under Members Only tab
 - Requires password
 - Contact Chapter Ceremonials Chairman to add/change information

Admission Degrees

- Councils hold primary responsibility
- DD should be aware and attend
- Live performed degree is preferred, but video is permitted (but c'mon, don't you want to really impress the candidate by performing in person?!)
- Provide kit to host degree team (rosary, pin, *These Men They Call Knights* booklet, etc.). FS can purchase kits at KofC.org
- Call/email the POC and inform of intent to attend and number of candidates
- DD submits Form 450 (Degree Exemplification Report) after degree (GK can remind him)
 - Number of candidates from each council, honoree, evaluation of degree team, etc.
 - Email to Supreme (<u>ceremonials@kofc.org</u>) and California State Council (<u>state.office@californiaknights.org</u>)

Formation Degrees

- District Deputy and Grand Knight hold joint responsibility
- Call/email the POC and inform of intent to attend and number of candidates
- DD submits Form 450 (Degree Exemplification Report) after degree (GK can remind him)
 - Number of candidates from each council, honoree, evaluation of degree team, etc.
 - Email to Supreme (<u>ceremonials@kofc.org</u>) and California State Council (<u>state.office@californiaknights.org</u>)
- NOTE: Nothing to provide to degree team captain

Knighthood Degrees

- District Deputies hold responsibility to request degree from State Deputy
 - State Deputy will assign a Conferring Officer
 - Cannot cancel degree without State Deputy concurrence
- Host DD MUST attend. DD's with candidates are strongly encouraged to attend
- Impress upon candidates to observe dress code jacket and tie
 - And sideliners have the same dress code
- Support the host council and enjoy their hospitality stay for the banquet!
- Host Council: Provides a secure venue (windows covered) with tables and chairs. Assigned Conferring Officer will coordinate with host DD to provide the equipment

Degree Teams

- More are needed consider forming or joining a team
 - State Membership Chairman has asked to host an admission degree in every district every month (12 districts in OC chapter x 12 months = 144 degrees)
 - Regional degrees make traffic bearable north, central, and south county
 - Scripts are available from DDs
 - Additional Knighthood degree participants needed please contact me if interested!!

Practice

- Learn the part from memory
- DD certifies team ready to perform
- Have backups/understudies ready to substitute during summer vacations
- Degree Team Dress Code
 - Jacket and tie with office jewel and ceremonial baldrics are preferred
 - Baldrics are only \$29 ea. through The English Company (MUCH LESS than robes)
 - Robes are still allowed (but not preferred)
