



Barometer of Our Success

2015 Annual Survey of Fraternal Activity Results

- USA/Canada Council Average
 - \$11,568 Council Donations
 - 4,865 Volunteer Hours
- USA/Canada Members Average
 - 34.2 Volunteer Hours
 - \$805 per Member





Barometer of Our Success

Your council's contribution tells a great Charitable Outreach Story

- \$23.56 per Volunteer Hour
 - How organizations calculate their charitable impact
 - Calculated by Bureau of Labor Statistics
- 34.2 hours x \$23.56 = \$805 per council member
- Council 51,845,051 volunteer hours = \$1.221 Billion Dollars
 - \$114,616.37 per council - Could you council write that check?



Barometer of Our Success

Council Review:

- Financial Secretary – Treasurer - Recorder
 - Add additional information to the council minutes
 - Checks are the easy part
- Program Director & Project Chairmen
 - After action report
 - Calculating your council's Volunteer Hours
- Calculating the value of donated food, goods and clothing



Individual Member Worksheet (#1728A)

Worksheet for each member to complete:

- Volunteer hours for the member and include family members at Knights of Columbus events
- Visits to Sick and Bereaved
- Blood Donations
- For Council Use – Do not send to Supreme



Barometer of Our Success

Calculating Volunteer Hours of Service - Example

-10 members + 5 family members + 5 Parishioners (Not Members visit a nursing home for 2 hours, visiting, playing games, singing songs.


How many hours should be calculated and reported on your Annual Survey of Fraternal Activity (#1728)?

-10 + 5 + 5 = 20 x 2 hours = 40 hours of volunteer service


